

Ocean Ski Club Lodge Rules (revised 2015)

The Lodge is a Smoke Free Environment.

- 1. Every member shall be held responsible for knowledge of the following rules.**
2. No person shall go to the lodge without first contacting the lodge chairman for availability and making arrangements for payment. In the event the lodge chairman cannot be contacted, notification of an officer or board member is necessary.
3. Any person found in the lodge without notifying the lodge chairman, officer, or board of directors, is subject to having his/her membership revoked.
4. All reservations must be made on an O.S.C. reservation form, accompanied by a check in full, made out to Ocean Ski Club, and received by the lodge chairman no later than 2 days prior to the reservation.
5. All cancellations must be within a 48 hour period prior to the reservation. A direct contact and confirmation of message or call by reservation chairman is required. All last minute cancellations may also require a call to the Ski Lodge.
6. Bed lists will be posted on the bulletin board as soon as possible. Any person leaving for the lodge during a weekday or early Friday should call the lodge chairman (732-528-7708) for room assignment or bed list.
7. Upon arrival at lodge, all members and guests are required to sign in the log book provided with dates of stay and room.
8. All persons shall be held responsible for "cleaning up" after themselves in the dorms, lavatories, kitchen, dining room, and recreation area.
9. Quiet shall be maintained after 10 p.m. Arrivals after 10 p.m. should be aware others may be sleeping.
10. All persons using any dining or kitchen facilities shall be held responsible for cleaning these facilities. This includes washing, drying, and putting away all dishes.
11. Parents are to be responsible for the conduct and any damages incurred by their children.
12. Guest reservations - Members shall have priority over guests for availability until 48 hours before reservations begin.
13. All guests shall be accompanied by a member while visiting the lodge and said member shall be held responsible for the conduct and any damages incurred by the guest.
14. All perishables shall be removed from the refrigerator every week-end.

15. No pets of any kind are allowed at any time in the lodge.
16. Lights should be turned off in bedrooms and other areas when the rooms are not occupied. Thermostats must be turned down when leaving each morning.
17. Be aware of fireplace rules and regulations.
18. The last person to leave the lodge on weekends shall lock up and follow the procedures listed on the bulletin board for closing. Be sure all thermostats are set to 55 degrees.
19. There shall be no consecutive stay of more than 14 nights or total of 50 nights without board approval. Guests are limited to two stays per season. Subsequent stays are subject to board approval.
20. Use common sense and courtesy at all times.

Revised Fireplace Instructions

1. No children starting or fueling fire.
2. No splitting or dropping wood on hearth.
3. No ski boots, gloves, clothing, etc. on hearth.
4. When starting a fire, use dry kindling or fireplace starter, and avoid smoke caused by too much paper or wet wood. Leave door space for vent.
5. Allow fire to die down & close door before bedtime.
6. Clean fireplace/hearth and replace cover over glass when cool (next morning) before leaving or skiing as heat will escape up the flue.
